

Drug Benefit Coverage

If you are covered by a drug benefit plan it can save costs on prescription drugs so you can get the medication(s) you need. Depending on where you live and your circumstances, you may qualify for one or more of the available federal, provincial, or territorial drug plans. Please see the following for detailed information on drug benefit coverage programs that may be available to you.

If you are enrolled in a group benefit plan, please check with your health benefits provider to see what is covered under your plan.

For Health Care Providers – when deciding on a treatment plan, please consider if there is an option that is covered by a drug plan your patient qualifies for. Please see below for information on which drugs are included in the National Indigenous and Ontario drug benefit plans.
